I. JESUS DIED AS <u>CONQUEROR</u> OVER THE POWERS OF EVIL

Colossians 2:15 (NIV) And having disarmed the powers and authorities, he made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them by the cross.

- II. JESUS DEFEATED THE POWERS OF EVIL:
 - by his <u>perfect obedience</u> to the will of His Father.

Romans 5:19 (NIV) For just as through the disobedience of the one man the many were made sinners, so also through the obedience of the one man the many will be made righteous

• by bearing the <u>consequences</u> of our disobedience.

Colossians 2:13–14 (NIV) When you were dead in your sins and in the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made you alive with Christ.

III. WHY DO CHRISTIANS STILL BATTLE WITH THEM?

• They have been conquered but not <u>obliterated</u>.

Ephesians 6:11- 13 NIV Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. ¹²For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. ¹³Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand.
