Effective Prayer Habakkuk 3:1- 2 NIV

BAD NEWS: LIFE IS DIFFICULT.

Habakkuk 1:3b–4 Destruction and violence are before me; there is strife, and conflict abounds. Therefore, the law is paralyzed, and justice never prevails. The wicked hem in the righteous, so that *justice is perverted.*

GOOD NEWS: THERE IS ALWAYS HOPE FOR JESUS FOLLOWERS.

a. The righteous shall live by faith.

Hab 2:4 ESV Behold, his soul (the enemy) is puffed up; it is not upright within him, but the righteous shall live by his faith.
