1. JES	US ABOUT THE FALL OF JERUSALEM.
	Matthew 24:21-22 For then there will be great distress, unequaled from the beginning of the world
	until now—and never to be equaled again. If those days had not been cut short, no one would survive,
	but for the sake of the elect those days will be shortened.
	Many believe that this foreshadows Jesus' 2 nd Coming.
	Signs: false teachers, wars, natural disasters, persecution, apostasy, along with gospel growth.
	Matthew 24:8 All these are the beginning of birth pains.
2. JES	US' OFT-REPEATED WARNING: BY FALSE TEACHERS.
	Matthew 24:23-28 At that time if anyone says to you, 'Look, here is the Messiah!' or, 'There he is!' do
	not believe it. For false messiahs and false prophets will appear and perform great signs and wonders to
	deceive, if possible, even the elect. See, I have told you ahead of time. So if anyone tells you, 'There he
	is, out in the wilderness,' do not go out; or, 'Here he is, in the inner rooms,' do not believe it. For as
	lightning that comes from the east is visible even in the west, so will be the coming of the Son of Man. Wherever there is a carcass, there the vultures will gather.
	Until His Return, Jesus gave us directed by His and empowered by
	Col 3:16 Let the Word of Christ dwell in you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom, and as you sing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God.

3. WH	EN JESUS RETURNS, EVERYTHING WILL BE
	Matthew 24:29-31 Immediately after the distress of those days 'the sun will be darkened, and the moon
	will not give its light; the stars will fall from the sky, and the heavenly bodies will be shaken.' Then will
	appear the sign of the Son of Man in heaven. And then all the peoples of the earth will mourn when they
	see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven, with power and great glory. And he will send his
	angels with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of the

2 Peter 3:10–13 But the day of the Lord will come like a thief.
